

Root Canal Treatment Has Been Completed

If your root canal treatment has been completed, this means that the process of cleaning and shaping then filling the canals inside of your tooth has been completed.

After this appointment you may experience some discomfort associated with the work that has been done for you on this tooth. However, the discomfort should be able to be controlled with routine headache medicine such as Aspirin, Tylenol, or Advil and it should be improving over the several days following your appointment.

While we do not anticipate any problems developing or continuing after the conclusion of your treatment with us, if you are experiencing any concerns, you are encouraged to call us. Certainly, if you are experiencing discomfort that is beyond what routine over-the-counter medications will handle or if your discomfort does not seem to be improving after a few days, then please call our office at (509) 928-8762.
