

Root Canal Treatment Has Been Started But Not Completed

To our Patients:

If your root canal treatment has been started but has not been completed, this means that the process of cleaning and shaping the canals inside of your tooth is underway.

After this appointment you may experience some discomfort associated with the work that has been done for you on this tooth. However, the discomfort should be able to be controlled with routine headache medicine such as Aspirin, Tylenol, or Advil and it should be improving over the several days following your appointment.

If you are experiencing discomfort that is beyond what these medications handle or if you are feeling pressure building up under your tooth or if there is any remaining cold or heat discomfort, then please call our office at (509) 928-8762.

If you need to contact our office after hours, you will be directed to Dr. McKinley's home phone number, if there is not an answer at this number then leave a message so that he can return your call.

If you are experiencing rapidly developing swelling, or have previously existing swelling that is involving your eye or is under the jaw or is involving the neck or swallowing or is difficult then call Dr. McKinley immediately. If there is not an answer then you are urged to visit the nearest hospital emergency room.
